

# LOCAL RULES 2011

## CLUB TOURNAMENTS

The local rules as printed on this sheet are the only valid local rules.

### **1. Out of Bounds Electric fence**

For protection of electric fence and avoiding electric shock, relief may be taken when the ball lies within 2 club-lengths of the electric fence. The player must drop within an additional club length away from the fence not nearer to the hole.

**No relief permitted if relief would place the ball nearer to the hole. In this case, the ball must be played as it lies, and avoiding any damage to the electric fence!**

### **2. Out of bounds**

- a. Over and beyond any boundary fence or margin of the course as marked by white stakes/white line. The line defines the boundary.
- b. The boundary of the house to the right of 1<sup>st</sup> green.
- c. Internal out of bounds between 10 and the compact course.
- d. Behind and to the left of the 10<sup>th</sup> green.

### **3. Staked trees**

Staked trees are to be considered as an integral part of the course. The ball must be played as it lies. Stakes cannot be removed.

### **4. Ground under Repair (G.U.R.)**

All areas marked by blue stakes and / or a line of blue paint. The line defines the areas marked.

### **5. Paths**

**All paths are an integral part of the course, the ball must be played as it lies unless otherwise marked as G.U.R.**

### **6. Stones in Bunkers**

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies)

### **7. Exceptional weather conditions**

The ball can be placed within the length of one scorecard through the green and in the semi-rough. This is a provisional measure as some areas of the course have suffered due to a long period of drought.
