

LOCAL RULES 2022



The local rules as printed on this sheet are the only valid local rules.

1. Protection of new plantations:

All areas of with new plantations are marked by **blue posts with green caps** are **NO PLAY ZONES**.

ENTERING THIS AREAS (ALSO TO PICK UP THE BALL) AND PLAYING BALLS FROM WITHIN THESE AREAS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN!

Free relief must be taken under Rule 16.1b.

(The nearest point of complete relief should be identified, and a ball must be dropped in and come to rest in the relief area. The relief area is one club-length from the reference point, is not nearer to the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area. When taking relief, the player must take complete relief from all interference by the abnormal course condition.).

The Golf de Clervaux reserves the right to impose a course ban and / or disqualification in the event of non-compliance.

2. Out of Bounds

Over and beyond any margin marked by white stakes/white lines or any other boundary fence (except fence clearly marked in red) or any hedges defining the boundary of the course.

Also, the boundary of the area around the house to the right of the 1st green as well as the whole compact course are out of bounds.



3. Dropping Zones: Holes 10 & 16

As an additional option to those provided under Rule 17 (penalty areas), dropping zones have been designated behind the green on hole 10 and behind the green on hole 16.

4. Hole 16: Penalty area BEHIND the green

The penalty area behind the green is defined by an electric fence with RED stakes.

The fence and the stakes must not be removed. If the fence or the red stakes are interfering with your swing in the general area (but not in the penalty area), you may take free relief by dropping a ball in and playing it from the Dropping Zone.

5. Paths

All paths and tracks, whether man-made or not, are abnormal course conditions under Rule 16. Free relief may be claimed under Rule 16.1b.

6. Staked Trees

Staked trees as well as the stakes are to be considered an integral part of the course.

The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable. Stakes must not be removed.

7. Electric fences

Electric fences are to be considered an integral part of the course.

The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable. Stakes of the fence must not be removed.

8. Ground under Repair - G.U.R.

All areas marked by blue stakes and / or a line of white or blue paint are considered G.U.R., you may claim free relief under rule 16.1.

9. Pace of Play

Play Ready Golf whenever possible, except in Matchplay.

"Your place on the course is not in front of the flight that follows you, but immediately behind the flight that precedes you ".
