



Local Rules 2024



Plantation Protection Zone at Hole 1: The Out of Bounds on the left side of hole 1 marked by WHITE / GREEN Stakes is a plantation protection zone, and it is strictly forbidden to enter it, even to fetch your ball. The WHITE / GREEN Stakes are Boundary Objects from which free relief is not allowed.

Plantation Protection Zones on other areas of the Course : The planting areas marked with BLUE / GREEN Stakes or BLUE Stakes with additional signs indicating that the area is an environmental protection zone are No Play Zones, and it is strictly forbidden to enter them, even to fetch the ball. If the ball rests in one of these areas, the player must take Free Relief. This is also true if the area interferes with the player's stance or intentional movement.

Out of Bounds: Over and beyond any margin marked by WHITE Stakes / Lines, any other boundary fence or beyond any hedges defining the Boundary of the course. The Boundary of the area around the house to the right of the green on Hole 1, as well as the entire Compact Course are Out of Bounds.

Ground Under Repair - G.U.R: All areas marked with BLUE Stakes and/or BLUE Lines are Ground Under Repair. The Player is entitled to a Free Relief.

Paths : All roads and paths on the course, even if not artificially-surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which Free Relief is allowed.

Electric Fences: Electric fences are Boundary Objects from which free relief is not allowed. The ball must be played as it lies, or can be declared unplayable. The fence stakes must not be moved.

Tree Roots : If a player's ball rests in the general area and there is an interference by bare roots, the player may take Free Relief. However, relief is not allowed if the roots only interfere with the player's stance.

Bare Spots : Free Relief from bare spots in General Area. Reference Point: The spot in the general area right behind where the ball is at rest.
Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: One club-length in the General Area.

Damage Ruts : The damage ruts made by maintenance vehicles are Abnormal Course Conditions. The player may take free Relief.



Pace of Play : Ready Golf is to be applied, except in Matchplay.

Your place on the course is not in front of the flight that follows you,
but immediately behind the flight in front of you !
